

Hello! We miss you!

We are so excited to welcome you back for the Fall Session. We have made some changes to comply with state and city guidelines to keep us all safe. While we expect these changes to remain in place for the duration of the Fall Session, we will adjust as needed based on current guidelines.

The Clubhouse Game Room will remain closed at this time. All classes at the Clubhouse have been cancelled for the Fall Session. Judo will still be held at the Old Town Triangle Association next door, but the Game Room will not be open for before and after class care.

You will notice changes to our regular programming like limited capacities and adjustments to activities to eliminate contact between participants. For example, Judo and Taekwondo will now be non-contact individualized training classes. We will offer a new Friday night event once per month as well as some additional RetroActive Sports afterschool programming to get kids active after a day of remote or hybrid learning.

The following policies will remain in place until we receive further guidance:

- Do NOT enter facility if you or someone in your household has confirmed COVID-19 or symptoms similar to those of COVID-19 (fever, cough, fatigue, shortness of breath).
- Participants' temperatures will be taken upon entry to our facilities.
- Please maintain social distance of 6 feet at all times.
- Use hand sanitizer and/or wash hands frequently.
- Masks are required in the facilities at all times, including while participating in classes.
- Only participants who have scheduled courses and/or scheduled lessons may enter the building. No walk-ins allowed.
- Classes/groups must consist of 10 participants or less.
- Participants may only enter facility when instructor is on premises and no more than 10 minutes in advance.
- Participants must leave when their class/lesson is finished.
- Parents must wait for participants outside of the facility. No spectators will be allowed.
- Participants and instructors (except fencers) must enter and exit through the main Drucker Center front door.
- Fencers will enter directly into Drucker Center West Studio (not the front door) when the instructor invites them in.
- Judo players will check-in for class directly at the Old Town Triangle South Room door. The Clubhouse Game Room will not be open.
- Please only bring what is needed for your class/lesson. Lockers are not available at this time.
- Our water fountains are unavailable. Bring a pre-filled water bottle or plan to purchase a water bottle from the Drucker Center vending machine.
